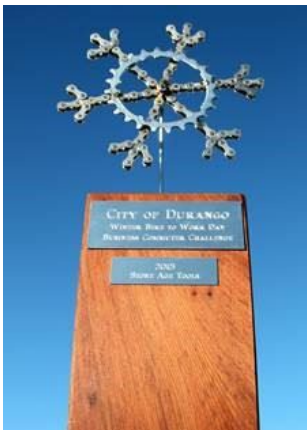

Durango Transit and Road Runner Transit partnership extends to Tech Center

Beginning Monday, January 28, the Southern Colorado Community Action Agency's **Road Runner**

Transit will extend public transit service from the Durango Transit Center to the Durango Tech Center on US Highway 160 West. Road Runner Transit will serve the Tech Center four times a day, Monday-Friday. Durango Transit passes and transfers will be accepted as fare.

In April 2018, Durango Transit and Road Runner Transit successfully coordinated an innovative partnership, allowing Durango Transit passholders to ride Road Runner Transit at no additional charge. On Monday, January 28, the service will extend from seven daily trips between Mercy Regional Medical Center and the Durango Transit Center to include four round trips per day from the Durango Transit Center to the Durango Tech Center. All Durango Transit passes and transfers will be accepted as eligible fare on the Road Runner service. For more information, visit DurangoTransit.com.
