Reminders From The City of Durango



- ❄️ See the map on the back side of this page, or visit durangogov.org/snow and type in your address in the interactive map to see if you live along a snow route
- ❄️ Don't park your car on a snow route if it snows more than 2 inches
- ❄️ Find off street parking if leaving for an extended period of time
- ❄️ It is the duty of the owner/occupant of any property abutting or adjoining any public sidewalk to remove all snow and ice from such sidewalk
- ❄️ It is against City code to move snow or ice onto city streets, unless it is being removed from the public sidewalk
- ❄️ Check for unprotected waterlines in unheated areas like crawlspaces, attics, garages, and basements and ensure they are properly protected against freezing

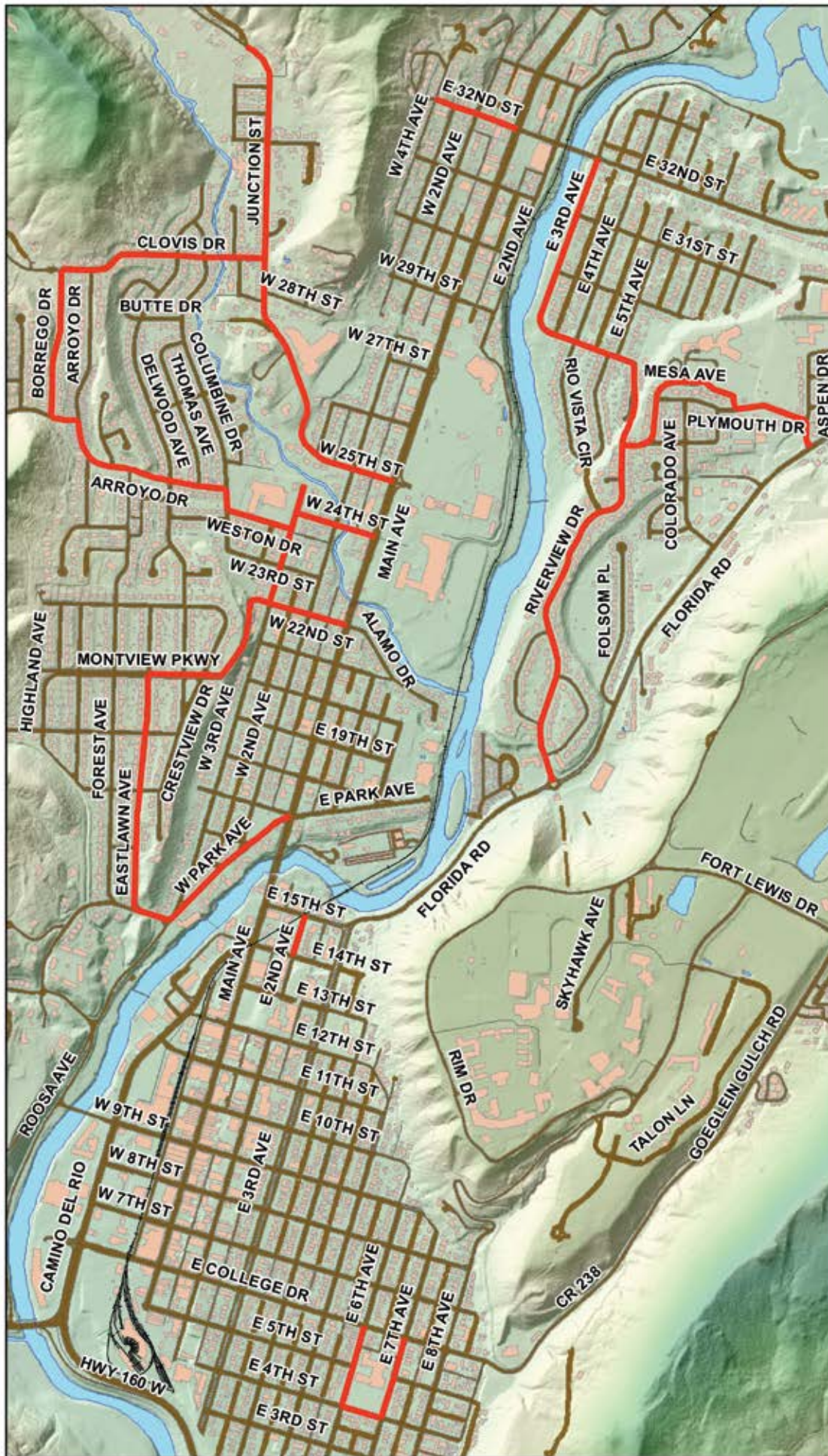
