Instructions

1. Determine from Water Division (375-4880 or 375-4881) if hydrant meter is available.
2. Obtain application from Public Works Office (1235 Camino del Rio) or Water Division (105 Sawyer Drive).
3. Complete the application.
4. Pay \$150 (3/4") or \$200 (3") fee and get receipt for validation of application at:
Finance Department – 949 E. 2nd Avenue
Public Works Department – 1235 Camino del Rio
City Service Center Warehouse – 105 Sawyer Drive
5. Call City Water Division personnel to install meter whether City-supplied or contractor-supplied.
6. ***Meter may only be moved from original hydrant location by City personnel – call 375-4880 or 375-4881 to make arrangements. There will be a \$25.00 charge each time it is moved.***
7. A water account will be set up by the Water Division using information on the application on the date that the meter is installed.
