Ski Shuttle Service from Durango starts Nov. 27

Durango, CO: The City of Durango is once again partnering with Purgatory Resort to offer a ski shuttle service for the 2019-2020 ski season. The Skier Shuttle, operated by Purgatory's Transportation Services, offers round trips to and from the Durango Transit Center for \$10 per person on weekends and select holidays starting Wednesday, November 27.
