## E-bikes Meeting Rescheduled for March 4

**Durango, CO:** The previously scheduled Joint Advisory Board Meeting on electric bicycles (E-bikes) has been rescheduled for Wednesday, March 4 from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the Durango Community Recreation Center, 2700 Main Avenue.

The Natural Lands Preservation, Parks and Recreation, and Multimodal advisory boards are holding the meeting to discuss E-bikes on City of Durango natural surface trails. Public comments will be accepted.

Currently, E-bikes are not permitted on City natural surface trails. However, Class I and Class II E-bikes are allowed on City hard surface trails, including the Animas River Trail, Florida Road Trail, Goeglein Gulch Road Trail, SMART 160 Trail and the Three Springs Trail.
