Durango, CO: Durango Parks and Recreation Department's school-age childcare program, [Gametime](#), begins Monday, June 15 at Chapman Hill Pavilion. The program for ages 5 to 13, is available Mondays through Fridays from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The cost is \$27 per day or \$22 per day if you register for an entire month. Registration is available [online only](#) and must be done a day or more in advance (no day of registrations). Space is limited.

The program will be following the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's COVID-19 safety guidelines for [Childcare Facilities](#). Children must wear face coverings; this requirement is subject to change. Group sizes will be limited to 10 to 20 participants depending on the activity.
