Fire Department and Parks & Rec to Offer Free Community Education Classes

Durango, CO: The Durango Fire Protection District and Durango Parks and Recreation are partnering to offer free community education classes at the Durango Community Recreation Center. The schedule is as follows:

November 4 from 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.
4. Basic First Aid
November 18 from 4:30 - 6:30pm
5. House Fires: The Risks & Causes
December 2 from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Classes are limited to 20 participants to allow for social distancing. Masks will be required, and participants may be asked to assist with disinfection practices.
