**Please adhere to the following rules and restrictions:**

- Due to capacity requirements, please limit time in the facility to 90 minutes.
- Every individual entering the aquatics area must have a reservation and pay the entrance fee, even if they are not swimming.
- Masks are required in the recreation center and aquatics area. Masks may be removed once swimmers enter the water.
- Children 14 and younger must be accompanied an adult.
