Durango Parks and Recreation to open Lake Nighthorse Friday, April 1

Durango, CO: Lake Nighthorse Recreation Area will open for the 2022 season this Friday, April 1. The lake will be open for non-motorized recreation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, April 1 through May 8. Daily operations will begin May 13, and motorized recreation begins May 15.
