PLANNED Pedestrian Improvements

LOCATION:

North Main Avenue, between 29th and 30th Streets

SCOPE:

Construct a mid-block pedestrian crossing

- Install ADA ramps on both sides of Main Street
- Install raised pedestrian refuge in center lane
- Install Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) light signal



PURPOSE, NEED & BENEFITS:

- A safer, more substantial improvement is needed between the current available pedestrian crossings at 27th and 32nd Streets.
- Vehicles rarely slow and yield to the pedestrians as state law requires.
- RRFB can alert oncoming traffic of pedestrians attempting to cross Main Avenue and encourages drivers to slow down.
- Raised pedestrian refuge island provides a safe place for pedestrians to stand in the center lane location while attempting to cross Main Avenue.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS: Intermittent lane closures and traffic shifts

TIMELINE: *TENATIVE* May—July 2022

COST: \$350,000
