1. \$5 Entry Fee.
2. Parade starts at 5:00 pm sharp on Tuesday, July 4.
3. Parade assembly / staging will begin at approximately 3:15 pm at College and Main to 5th Street, then on 5th street to 3rd Avenue. Enter the staging area on 3rd Avenue north of 5th street and follow the directions of the parade marshals.
4. All parade entries must agree to abide by the City Ordinances that prohibit throwing of items from parade entries. Items may be handed to the crowd by persons walking along side of the parade entry.
5. This parade is designed to celebrate the 4th of July; float design and messages should reflect the spirit of celebration. Controversial pro or con positions should be avoided. Parade entries must be family-friendly.
6. The contact person above agrees to be in attendance on or with the parade entry throughout parade route and is responsible for the entry as well as others on the entry to assure compliance with all Fourth of July policies.
