City of Durango Public Parking Permit Regulations Monthly Permits

Parking Permit Holders are required to comply with the following regulations when parking in all City owned municipal parking facilities.

1. All parking permits are \$30 per calendar month and will be sold on a first come - first served basis: Permits will be prorated by the week if sold during the month. The purchase of three or more continuous months shall entitle the purchaser to a 15% discount. Permits are valid only at the Transit Center Parking Lot (Car Park) located between 7th and 8th Streets at Camino del Rio; and for the three 2nd Ave lots located at (NOT AT CITY HALL):

East lot 2- 600 Block E 2nd Ave East lot 3- 700 Block E 2nd Ave East lot 4- 800 Block E 2nd Ave

- 2. Municipal lot spaces are reserved for permit holders for the hours of 7 AM 5 PM, Monday Friday (except Holidays). Permits are not needed on Saturday, Sundays, or City Holidays or evenings.
- 3. The permit entitles the Permit Holder to one marked space. Therefore, trailers, RV's or other combination vehicles are not allowed in the lots Monday Friday, 7 AM 5 PM. Holidays excluded.
- 4. Permits may not be loaned to unregistered vehicles, they may only be used by the Permit Holder(s) on vehicles which are listed on the application. During restricted hours, at no time shall more than one registered vehicle be allowed in the parking lots. The second vehicle found will receive a non-revocable citation.
- 5. Permits must be attached to the rearview mirror or be fully visible in the front windshield area, failure to properly display a current permit will result in a non-revocable citation being issued. Permitted vehicles may be tracked by license plate if and when the City acquires a license plate recognition system.
- 6. Overnight parking shall be allowed. However, vehicles left unattended for over 72 hours will be considered abandoned and may be towed.
- 7. The City of Durango is not responsible for damage due to accidents, or loss due to theft.
- 8. Display of "For Sale" signs on vehicles is not allowed. There shall be no advertising, of any kind in the municipal lots (city ordinance).
- 9. The general public is allowed to park for free after 5PM on weekdays and all day on weekends and holidays.
- 10. City owned or municipal off street parking lots are not intended to be used for commercial/political endorsements, or any activities that would interfere with the purpose of the facility. Any deviation from this provision will be considered on a case by case basis and will not be considered precedent for any future action.
- 11. Purchase of a parking permit does not guarantee a space. In the event that all spaces are occupied in municipal lots on E 2nd Ave and Car Park, permit holders <u>will not</u> be allowed to park in metered spaces free of charge when displaying a municipal permit. Parking citations will be issued for expired (unpaid) meters.
- 12. No refunds will be made for lost or stolen permits.
