What is Happening at the Skyline Trailhead?

The City of Durango Parks and Recreation Department is making parking, drainage and landscape improvements to the existing trailhead parking area for the Skyline Trail at the north end of Jenkins Ranch Road. The project involves the creation of a defined area for head-in parking utilizing a permeable paved surface, concrete curb/gutter and sidewalk to replace the poorly draining existing parking area. Also included in the project is installation of drainage infrastructure within the street right-of-way and completion of restorative landscape seeding and mulching.

During the construction period, access to Skyline Trail will remain open and public parking for trail users will be directed to on-street parking on the nearby side streets, but not on Jenkins Ranch Road.
